Sharing your faith seem difficult? Try this method...

THINK

Start to think about and write down a small list (to start) of non-Christian students you are around at school. These can be students you know or may need to get to know.

PRAY

For the next few weeks and during your regular Friday (or group's chosen weekly before school EPIDEMIC prayer time) begin to pray for these students and for your friend's list of students. Begin to pray for these students and for opportunities to develop relationships with them. After time you can begin to know who they really are and their needs, developing opportunities to share with them God's love.

Do

Begin to look for opportunities to meet needs of these people and show you simply care about them. Find chances to invite them to hang out with you and your other Christian friends. Make an effort to invest your time into others lives. As you do you will gain their trust and attention. Begin to share with them what God has done in your life and what it means to have assurance of knowing where you go when you die.

After all isn't that what Jesus was about?

He invested time and cared for people.
Let's follow His example and spread love that can change hearts.
